04.9	Minutes and Agendas are not being displayed in the village cabinets/noticeboards.
04.10	 SMDC appears not to be actively engaging with Lockside to move the marquee. It is 15m x 9m x 4m and exceeds the permitted size. Lockside has requested extra time to remove it, which is unreasonable considering it has been on site now for 11 months. A resident has contacted Ben Haywood (Head of Planning) about this reluctance to act. SMDC previously informed Lockside that they needed to submit a planning application, as it is an unlawful building. This has not been done. Cllr Sybil Ralphs advised the meeting that the PC is opposed to the marquee. It is a conservation area. The PC has objected previously.
